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Dear Family in Christ:

It is our prayer that you, your family and loved ones are in good health and enjoying the blessings of our Heavenly Father. The following is a report of the activities carried out from June to November 2016. Yesenia, myself and our son Emmanuel want to thank you for your continuous prayers and financial support towards our work in Gods Kingdom with the children.



Meet the King Program

I thank God for the doors He opened in new Public Schools for us so that we might share the Good News of Salvation with the students. From January 2015 and onward, the ministry of

education made it more difficult to enter into the public schools. For that reason, the CEF team and I were praying during the whole year for open doors to evangelize the children in new public schools that we hadn't yet visited. This year in March when the Life Point Church team came to work with us, we visited one public school where we worked for a period of 5 years. They had a new principle who was not a Christian. She liked our presentation very much and we asked her if she knew of other principals who would allow us to enter into their schools. She gave us the name of one principle who also connected us with other principals from other schools. Suddenly we had a bunch of schools opening their doors for us. To date we have taught in 6 new public schools that we haven't taught in the past. We still have four more schools on hold for 2017. We praise the Lord for answering our prayers. So far we were able to reach 1,502 children, and of these children a total of 178 received Jesus as their Savior. We are very thankful as well since the teachers of the students in those schools were able to hear the Message of Salvation. This year we visited a total of 6 new schools.

OMETEPE

At the beginning of this year God opened the doors to a big opportunity to minister to the children on the Island of Ometepe. This Island is located in the Center of the Lake of Nicaragua and

has two Volcanoes, one of which is active. Ometepe is currently one of the destinations admired by both local and international tourists and has a population of 29,684 inhabitants. 3 years ago we met a missionary by the name of Tomas Fritz who has lived on the Island for 13 years working with pastors and local people. This brother told us that he had to stop due to health reasons and that he was praying for some ministry to come along who would work with the children and pastors in the area. As this is a tourist area, unfortunately not many develop evangelistic programs, especially for children. We felt right away that God was opening a door for us to minister to new children and give the vision to new pastors and leaders for child evangelism. We accepted the challenge. First we have already held an evangelistic activity in the feeding centre that the brother holds weekly,

Thanks to Bill Camenish who has been working in partnership with the Pastors on the Island, and has a close friendship with Tomas, CEF Nicaragua was able to make contact with and present its programs to the 40 pastors who work there locally in March 2016.

DISTRIBUTION OF DRIED FOOD

We would like to extend our thanks to Shelly Stone (Director of Gleaners of Ontario), John and Claire Tigchelaar as well as Phil and Suzanne Tyers for their help in shipping 732 bags of dehydrated vegetable mix, peanuts and dehydrated Apple chips. As seen above, part of those bags were distributed to the community of Veracruz in Rivas to a total of 250 families. As well we

brought some to the feeding centre on the Island of Ometepe and other churches in Managua to feed the hungry children. After 3 months of prayer and waiting patiently for the food to be released by the Customs agents in Nicaragua our prayers were answered and finally we were able to get the food to the children who most needed it.

TRAINING COURSES

The program that took of the majority of our time in the second half of this year were training courses held by CEF Nicaragua. One of the biggest blessings that God provided for us this year was that the ministry of Compassion international made a partnership with CEF Nicaragua. Because of this partnership, we were able to train more than 350 teachers in the departments of Managua, Masaya, Carazo, Leon, and Tipitapa. It was a big challenge since the groups that met were large. One of our challenges was to teach a TCE Level 1 course in Los Cedros where we had a total attendance of 53 students. The challenge was to check the homework, evaluate each student, and prepare material. At the same time that we held the course in Los Cedros, we had another course going on simultaneously in Managua where we had an attendance of 22 teachers. This was led by the other instructors in CEF Nicaragua. Even though we all finished

exhausted, it was a big blessing because we know that the teachers took on the vision to evangelize the children in their communities. Many of them gave testimonies where even their own children came to Christ when they were practicing the Wordless book. We already have various groups of students ready for the new year for Teaching Children Effectively level 1 in 2017.

We thank God for His Strength, wisdom, guidance and provision in this year that is finishing. Thanks to each one of you for being part of the Grand Labor in Gods Great Kingdom amongst the children. May the Lord Bless you all.
